Covid19 Update for Tally Church

Due to Covid 19 regulations we are operating under the "Ticketed Venue" option which means seats will be numbered and you will be required to book your seat prior to each service. You will then be allocated a numbered seat.

Bookings can be made by phoning Rob Roach on 0418715756. An attendance record is kept and held for 56 days for contact tracing purposes should someone test positive.

We are all asked not to congregate outside before or after church and to wear a mask when both entering and exiting the church (supplied by us if needed). Thankfully we do not need to wear the masks during the service.
