4 Keys to Living and Caring like Jesus

Refer to: Matt 14:12-14 and Mark 6: 30-34.

4 Ministry ideas

- 1. Sadness, Grief and the need for rest are real. John death touched Jesus in a profound way that made him want to withdraw and recuperate. Matt 14:13 When Jesus heard what had happened, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Mark 6:31 adds, 'because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, 'Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.' Jesus and the disciples needed R & R so do we.
- 2. Seeing with Jesus-like eyes. Mark 6:32-34 32 So they went away by themselves in a boat to a solitary place. 33 But many who saw them leaving recognised them and ran on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. 34 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd.

I suspect that for the disciples who were hungry, tired and upset about John's death (remember some were his followers) seeing the crowd as they arrived would have been a bitter blow to their hopes of solitude and recuperation. But notice Jesus' eye-sight – he sees people not an annoyance. He is moved by what he sees because they were like sheep without a shepherd. These people had no helpful leaders or protection or guidance – so he didn't withdraw again - he taught & healed them.

We at TUC do well to see people, not as problems - but with Jesus-like kind eyes.

3. Caring as Jesus cared. Mk 6:34 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. Compassion is a learned response; it comes from an open heart to other people's needs. Jesus saw the need and it affect him.

We at TUC do well to care for people with compassion – with a Jesus-like heart

4. Actions speak loudly Matt 14:14 14 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed those who were ill.. Mk 6:36 adds he began teaching them many things. Care led to action – word & deed.

We at TUC do well to act as Jesus acted – seeing, caring and helping (in word & deed)
